


# Energy challenges







TOP 10 countries' gross inland consumption of renewables compared with EU-28


Bioenergy grows at a good pace, dominated by the heat sector.

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


World pellet map and tradeflows

importing 7 Mtons.




# Bioenergy development


And carbon stock in forests is still growing because we harvest less than 2/3 of annual growth.


# European Union Policy

## Lessons learned

- Too generous **support schemes** offer short term impact only. It leads afterwards to acceptance crisis and less political support.
- **Sustainability** should be addressed from the beginning to ensure public acceptance, with a balanced and stable approach.
- Energy does not mean electricity. **Heat and transport** markets are challenging to decarbonize.

An example of crazy proposal aiming at banning round wood.




# Cooperation
